Powerboat

RYA Powerboat Level 2 (PB2)

The basic powerboat "driving license", no previous experience necessary. 2 day or 4 evening course. This is the minimum required to drive the club safety boats. We aim to run several courses through the season to get more people qualified to help on the safety boats. Minimum age 12. Those aged 12-15 at the end of the course will be issued with an endorsed certificate, to be used under supervision.

Dinghy Sailing

Monday Mayhem

Our regular Monday evenings for the whole family. Dinghy sailing, yachting, powerboating, we'll try to fit some of it all in. Some days we'll play games or do other activities near the club and others we might take a small trip up the sound.

If you're under 8 or haven't been sailing much before, take along a friend or family member to sail with. There will be instructors to help you with any problems you have from 18:00, come along and rig up a boat and get changed ready for sailing at 18:30.

Junior Beginners

A week of sailing, games, water, and (hopefully) sun, working towards RYA Stage 1 or 2. No previous experience necessary. You don't need to be a strong swimmer but water confidence is a must. Age 8+

Junior Improvers

Another week of sailing, games, water, and (hopefully) sun, but at a slightly more advanced level, working towards RYA Stage 3.

Course requirements: RYA Stage 2 (or equivalent)

Junior Advanced

A week of sailing for those who've mastered the skills from the Beginners and Improvers weeks, We'll be looking at bigger and faster boats, probably working towards RYA Stage 4 and possibly starting with some of the skills from the Advanced Modules. The exact syllabus will depend on what the students would like to focus on and what the weather allows.

Course requirements: RYA Stage 3 (or equivalent), an be confident sailing single handed, including upwind.

Adult Beginners

A weekend or 4 evening course starting with the absolute basics. No previous experience necessary. Working towards RYA Level 1.
