

# OBAN SAILING CLUB – PLAN FOR SAFE SAILING

## Key Requirements

- Under 16s accompanied by adult family member
- Under 12s to wear helmets
- Each boat skippered by a sailor capable of sailing a triangle course
- Everyone to contribute to keeping each other safe



## Social Distancing (SD) Challenges

- **In the Park:** avoid crowding the shed/slip
- **Launching/Recovery:** one boat at a time
- **Rigging Boats:** maintain 2m between boats
- **Safety Boats:** recovered sailors sit at stern



### Shed: 1 in - 1 out

#### In the Park

- ↳ One family group in shed at a time
- ↳ Shed doors to remain open
- ↳ Family assigned a club boat
- ↳ Assistance and advice with rigging with appropriate SD
- ↳ Rig check by shore helper
- ↳ Use hand sanitiser when necessary
- ↳ Boats to be cleaned as normal and left for 3 days before re-use
- ↳ Sanitation of tiller extensions

#### Control: 1x Shore Helper

- ↳ Control access to the shed
- ↳ Advise on and check boat rigging
- ↳ Oversee cleaning/sanitising

#### On the Water

- ↳ Only launch when a safety boat is on the water
- ↳ Launch/recover small boats as a family group
- ↳ Launch/recover big boats with SD
- ↳ Take advice from safety boat crews

#### Control: 2x Safety Boats

- ↳ Helm & Crew from one family
- ↳ PPE provided for use as required
- ↳ Promote self assistance
- ↳ Physical rescue last resort
- ↳ Rescued sailors brought to pontoon for further assistance

### Clubhouse: 1 in - 1 out

#### In the Clubhouse

- ↳ **No changing facility available**
- ↳ We will operate one unisex toilet
- ↳ **Adult helper is allowed to be with their child**
- ↳ Members responsible for using anti-viral spray after use
- ↳ **Additional regular cleaning**
- ↳ Wetsuits/BAs long term loans

#### Control: 1x Clubhouse Helper

- ↳ Control access to the clubhouse
- ↳ Issue wetsuits/buoyancy aids/helmets
- ↳ Safety oversight of sailing area
